Supervisor Trout asked Mr. Patrick Nicoletta, Project Engineer from the MRB Group to give an update on various ongoing Town Projects.

Manhole Rehab Project – Mr. Nicoletta said the majority the work is done, however, there is a Punch List that identified benches that are holding water. The company Advanced Rehabilitation said they will be coming back to correct the issue.

Councilman Lotz said he has been monitoring the flows and there is a definite improvement on the velocity of the flow.

Hydrogen Sulfide Project – Mr. Nicoletta said Evoqua was monitoring the system last week and tracking the hydrogen sulfide and what impact the bioxide is having on the system. Pat said there are still electrical concerns that the bioxide pumps will turn on at the same time. Pat said a technician from Evoqua will be here next week to monitor the system.

Sewer Use Law – Mr. Nicoletta said that he will be sending it out to the DEC this week and will also send it out to our Attorney, Dennis Benjamin to make sure nothing is out of the ordinary. Pat said once he gets the approval from the DEC, the Sewer Use Law should be completed by the first of the year.

South Pre-Emption Street Water – Mr. Nicoletta said he has provided more information requested by Mrs. Cindy Newcomb. If USDA is satisfied with this information, he said they could be providing us soon with a funding estimate. Mr. Nicoletta said he will follow-up this week with Mrs. Newcomb.

Seneca Cayuga Trail – Mr. Nicoletta said that the proposal they received to water seal the deck, spindles and handrails was over \$11,000.00. After discussion with the Town Board and Highway Superintendent, Joe Mull, it agreed that the town highway department would do the work.

Mr. Nicoletta has a cost estimate for the materials and said the Environmental Material for this project is \$2,585.70. He said the materials are Eco-Friendly and will not harm the vegetation. Councilman Lotz asked if the company is requiring doing this work every year. Mr. Nicoletta said he believes the company provides a 10-year warranty; however, he is not certain so he will confirm that with the company.
